GRS Laboratories examined a natural emerald of 18.95 ct, described in report number GRS2024-028574, demonstrating good characteristics worthy of a dedicated mention.

This remarkable emerald is distinguished by a rare combination of large size, an excellent vivid green color variety, good brilliance and transparency, and well-balanced proportions.

Analytical and advanced testing traces the origin of this gemstone to the prestigious and legendary mines of the Colombian Andes. The fascinating internal world of classical Colombian emerald inclusions is present in this particular emerald. At the time of testing, it was concluded that the gemstone had a minor degree of clarity enhancement.

This vividly saturated emerald is reminiscent in hue of the varieties displaying the legendary colors found in the world-renowned Muzo mines. They are formally described as Muzo Green and commonly known in the trade as **Old Mine** emeralds.

The combination of good attributes that this emerald displays was concluded to be important. The vivid green color radiates harmoniously in tone and color saturation. Excellent lapidary craftsmanship adds value to the nature of this gemstone.

Colombian emeralds of such large size and quality are rare.
